Guidelines for Oral Presentation

Oral presentation will be limited to **6 mins**. Submit the presentation as **PPT file (limited to 20 slides, Format is attached)** on or before 14th December 2022.

Guidelines for poster presentation

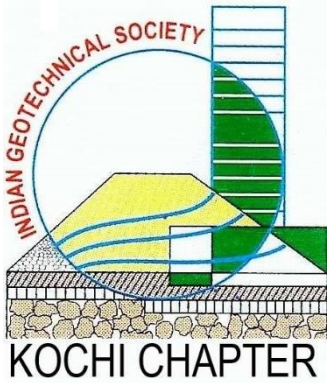
For poster presentation prepare presentation materials in **A1 size board**. Be sure to include the **abstract title, author and co-author names and the institution(s)** where research is underway.

The recommended font size for title of the paper is **86pt** and bold. All main headings and sub-headings must not be smaller than **60pt** and **48 pt**, respectively. Font sizes in the main text must not be smaller than **30pt**. It is suggested to include an **abstract** in the **upper left hand side** of the poster, followed by the headings- **“Introduction or background”, “Methods”, “Results”, and “Conclusions”**.

Include your contact information on these copies for attendees who desire further information.

The designated poster presenter must be present at the assigned space during the allotted time to discuss the work presented.

It is recommended that **you hand-carry your poster** to the conference. On site printing facility will not be available.
